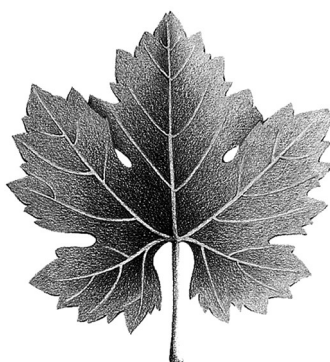

- Excellent colour, half suggesting the inclusion of viognier; prolonged oak ageing has not imposed itself on the wine, which is very intense, the quality particularly good for '07; lots of dark chocolate and fluffy tannins.

The Devil's Whiskers McLaren Vale Shiraz 2007

The elevated purple-crimson colour points to the 4% viognier inclusion, as does the aromatic bouquet; the palate has the dark chocolate and earth of the region, but there is a definite tweak from the viognier.
