

# Kangarilla Road Tasting Notes



## 2020 Kangarilla Road Pinot Grigio

Periods of unseasonably low temperatures in the Adelaide Hills and occasional strong winds during flowering resulted in highly variable fruit-set across the region. Exceptionally dry and occasionally hot conditions in December were a defining feature of the growing season. January and February brought cooler and wetter conditions, and ripening continued at a reasonable pace before slowing down due to cooler night temperatures.

Yields would have been similar to 2019 – lower than the long-term average – had it not been for losses to fire and smoke exposure.

A floral delight sings from the glass with beautifully perfumed honey suckle and jasmine blossoms. There are fresh mandarin notes, white peaches, touches of musk and the gentle tang of lemon sherbet.

The palate is alive with the white blossoms, delicious ripe honeydew melon and hints of the lemon sherbet. The wine has retained a blush of colour from contact with the grape skins. It has a lovely balanced weight and is beautifully textured and is reminiscent of long Summer afternoons.
